**POSTING DATE:** January, 2018

**POSITION:** Environmental Health Intern for Mosquito Control Program

**STATUS:** Temporary Status - Up to 24 hours per week (Monday-Friday) may include evening work. Position runs from May 14<sup>th</sup> – August 24<sup>th</sup> for a total of 16 weeks.

**Pay:** \$10.00 to \$11.00/hour

**RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:**

- ❖ Investigate nuisance mosquito complaints.
  - ❖ Educate residents of steps for mosquito abatement.
  - ❖ Collect mosquito larvae and/or adults for data analysis.
  - ❖ Assist with larvicide applications (ditches, package plants, catch-basins, etc.).
  - ❖ Assist with adulticide applications as needed (night spray, complaint abatement).
  - ❖ Execute evening adulticiding treatments as needed.
  - ❖ Maintain accurate records of mosquito treatment methods.
  - ❖ Maintain and store equipment responsibly.
  - ❖ Complete other mosquito control related tasks as needed.

**EDUCATION:**

- ❖ Qualified applicants should be pursuing a bachelor's degree or a graduate degree in public health or a related field.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- ❖ Must have a valid Ohio driver's license, in good standing.
  - ❖ Must be able to drive a full-size truck.
  - ❖ Must be a dependable individual.
  - ❖ Ability to read and understand written instructions and maps, ability to add and subtract whole numbers, and understand the safe handling of pesticides.
  - ❖ Must have an understanding of basic biology or science, and be capable of learning to respond to questions and concerns from the general public.
